## CHIPMUNK CAMP

4 TO 5 YEAR OLDS

Each session offers a half day program (9am-1pm) and a full day program (9am-4pm). Transportation for half day program is available in the morning only.

## BASIC DAY CAMP

6 TO 12 YEAR OLDS

## LEADER IN TRAINING

13 TO 14 YEAR OLDS

Young adults will be inspired and challenged by talented professionals in a series of activities designed to build character, confidence, and leadership skills. Throughout the summer, LITs will have the opportunity to shadow and support the various activity specialists, and work on a community service project throughout the summer! Campers will also enjoy swimming, sports, crafts, archery and more. Enroll early, limited amount of spots available!

## COUNSELOR IN TRAINING

15 YEAR OLDS

The CIT program forms the link between the older campers' programs and counseling positions. It combines leadership skills development, instruction in conducting camp and recreational activities and closely supervised leadership experiences with campers on a regular basis. Contact the Camp Director to receive a CIT application and background check forms. All CITs are interviewed by the Camp Director or Assistant Director to ensure this is the right fit. Enroll early, only 10 spots available and deadline for the program is May 1, 2012.

# YOUTH SPECIALTY PROGRAMS

## DRAMA CAMP

6 TO 9 YEAR OLDS (SESSION 1 ONLY)  
10 TO 15 YEAR OLDS (SESSION 2 ONLY)

An entry-level program designed for the creative child interested in acting, dancing, singing and theatre. Activities will include creative dynamic workshops and small productions that will culminate in a "Broadway" show. Some regular camp activities also included. Campers will need to bring in costume materials as the session progresses. Enroll early as space is limited!

Fee: \$415

## DANCE CAMP

6 TO 9 YEAR OLDS (SESSION 3 ONLY)  
10 TO 15 YEAR OLDS (SESSION 4 ONLY)

Dance Camp is an introductory level program designed for campers who love to dance! This unique program will offer ballet, modern and hip-hop dance styles. Along with learning and improving proper techniques, dancers will be able to assist in the choreography of their final production. Campers will need to bring ballet shoes, leotards, tights, and/or appropriate clothing. Enroll early as space is limited!

## SWIM LESSONS

4 TO 14 YEAR OLDS

This daily 45-minute class is designed for swimmers and non-swimmers alike. This step-by-step progression of swimming and safety skills enables an individual to swim safely, enjoy the water, and use swimming as a lifetime sport. A swim test will help determine what swim level your child is at.

## HORSEBACK RIDING

8 YEAR OLDS & ABOVE

This daily 45-minute class will develop the camper's appreciation of riding, grooming, feeding and handling of horses. Classes are offered to non-campers if any openings exist. Space is limited to two sessions per camper for the entire summer.

9 TO 12 YEAR OLDS (SESSIONS 1 & 3)

This two week camp is a sports enthusiasts dream! Each day we will focus on a different sport from baseball, basketball, flag football, soccer, kickball and many more. We will work on improving skills, teamwork, sportsmanship and real game situations. After learning about each sport, we will take to the road to visit New England's greatest sports destinations including Fenway Park, Gillette Stadium, Basketball Hall of Fame, and a Pawtucket Paw Sox game. # TRANSPORTATION

## BUS INFORMATION

Bus Transportation is available for all campers and is included with your camp fee (unless otherwise noted). Camp Clark provides two bus monitors on each bus. Campers must be supervised by an adult at pick-up and drop-off locations. **If an adult is not present, your child will be brought back to Camp Clark for pick-up.** Please note: Bus routes are subject to change.

Bus accommodations will not be confirmed until camp payment is received in full. Please indicate your preferred stop and bus number on the registration form. Busing services are not guaranteed if registration or payment is late.

Bus times are approximate. Please allow 15 minutes in the morning and afternoon. Drop off is in reverse order and the departing time from camp is 4:00pm. Bus routes depend on enrollment and are therefore subject to change. If your bus time changes, you will be notified by mail prior to your camp session.

**We ask that no child will be dismissed between 3:30 – 4:00 (unless of an emergency) due to closing announcement and bus dismissal. Please plan your schedule accordingly.**

Camp Clark is approx. 4 miles down on the right. Note: The main road name changes to Hedges Pond Rd. shortly before the camp entrance. **From Exit 2:** Take 3A North to Hedges Pond Road on the left. Camp is 1.5 miles down on the left.

- **Refund Policy:** All fees are non-refundable with the exception of a note from a physician stating your child cannot attend camp for medical reasons. Refund requests need to be made before or during the session. No refunds will be made due to failure to attend, incomplete attendance, or inclement weather.
- **Change Policy:** All program change requests must be received in writing at least one week prior to the beginning of each session. Requests will only be honored if space is available and needs to be submitted to the Camp Director.
- **Payment Policy:** Enclose the required \$75 non-refundable deposit for each child per session. This deposit will be credited towards your tuition balance and it cannot be transferred to other programs or sessions. **Payment for camp is due 4 weeks prior to the start of the first session you are registering your child for. Payment for Session 1 is due by May 25th; Session 2 by June 11th; Session 3 by June 25th; Session 4 by July 9th. Camp session payment(s) is due 4 weeks prior to the start of the first registered camp session.** If payments are not received or if you are registering for a session less than four weeks prior to its start date, a \$25 late registration fee will be charged and added to your final payment.
- **A Fee of \$20.00 will be charged to all NSF transactions.**

## IMPORTANT FAQs FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

### How does Camp Clark select its staff?

Counselors and instructors are selected for sound judgment, maturity, experience, camping skills, leadership skills and their desire to work with children in the camping environment. Counselors come from a variety of backgrounds including human service majors in college, exemplary high school students, and campers who have gone through our C.I.T. program. All staff must pass reference and criminal background checks.

### What type of training does the staff have?

All staff undergo a minimum 5 day orientation that covers a variety of topics that include counseling skills, team building, programming, conflict resolution, and sensitive issues such as child abuse and neglect. Aquatic staff are certified lifeguards and undergo a 3 day training specific to our facility. Senior and specialty staff are CPR and First Aid certified. Rope directors are certified by trained professionals.

### What is the staff to camper ratio?

For ages 6 years and under, the ratio is 1 staff per 5 campers. For ages 7 years and older, the ratio is 1 staff per 10 campers.

### What medical information does the camp need?

A copy of the health history form is attached in this brochure. Under Massachusetts State law, each camper must have a recent physical and immunization form, signed by a licensed physician, on file prior to attending camp. We require each camper to have a physical dated within 2 years prior to admission. Current physical and immunization records from your child's school are acceptable. Completed health forms must be in our files before your child may be registered for camp.

### Do you offer financial assistance? Yes.

Thanks to generous donations from YMCA families, staff, camp alumni and friends, funds are available to those who may not be able to afford a camp experience for their child. Partial tuition for one session is applied towards camp fees. Confidential campership applications are available on request and must be submitted by May 11, 2012. For more information, please contact the Camp Secretary.

### What happens if my child gets sick at camp?

The care of mildly ill campers, administration of medications, and emergency care is overseen by a registered nurse who is on-site daily. A pediatric physician is available during camp hours to provide consultation or emergency care. Based on the emergency contact information provided, a parent or guardian will be contacted if the child needs to leave camp because of sickness.

### What should my child bring to camp?

Every day, campers should bring a bathing suit, towel, a non-perishable bag lunch, sunscreen, bug spray, and a water bottle from home.

### How is the camp licensed?

Camp Clark is licensed by the local Department of Public Health and follows all state camp regulations. Our ropes course is inspected on an annual basis.

### What happens when it rains or when it is extremely hot and humid?

In the case of thunder, lightning and torrential downpours, all campers are brought inside. In the case of light rain or extreme heat, we try to continue all activities outdoors utilizing the pavilion and tent areas, however ropes course, archery and other activities may be closed and campers moved to alternate activities/locations. We do request that you prepare your camper with clothes/gear for all weather. Camp leadership staff will make decisions during inclement weather to ensure safety for all campers.
