How do I register?

If you would like to register:

- \$60 deposit required to request to hold a spot per week* (deposit is fully refundable)
- Full payment required has been extended to July 1st 2021.

Please note that all camps are still operating under a limited capacity for the safety of our campers and staff. Space is limited, and enrollment is filling quickly!

What are the camp hours?

Camp will run from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

Extended care will be offered at an additional cost from 8:00 am to 9:00 am and 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm. All campers must be registered to attend extended care.

Are you still offering specialty camps?

We are operating under the assumption that we will not be offering specialty camps, however that is subject to change as we receive more information and guidance from our local Board of Health, Department of Public Health, and the Governor.

Are you still offering the CIT program?

Yes, we will be able to offer a CIT program this year.

Are my deposit or payments refundable?

All payments are risk free. We know things are changing each day and prior to camp starting, all payments are fully refundable. If we are unable to run camp or are unable to honor your registration you will be refunded fully.

When do camps need to be paid in full by?

July 1st

What precautions will be taken to keep my child safe from Covid 19 while at camp?

The Y is constantly working toward a plan to ensure we are providing the best possible care, including new social distancing protocols and implementing new requirements from the Department of Public Health.

Based on guidance and direction from the Governor and CDC, and our local board of health, our plans include:

- Spreading children out in smaller groups and physically distancing them around camp
- Not allowing children or staff at camp who are exhibiting symptoms
- Increased hand washing and accessibility to hand sanitizer
- Disinfection and cleaning of all areas
- Revised pick up and drop off procedures to limit contact and exposure

We will add to this list as we receive more information.

What happens if a child or staff member at the camp tests positive for Covid 19?

We will strive to ensure all campers and staff are proactively scanned and all social distancing guidelines are adhered to. In the case that there was a suspected case of COVID-19 we will work with our local Board of Health and the Department of Public Health to ensure we minimize the risk to any campers or staff.

What are the next steps after I submit my registration form?

You will receive a confirmation once we have received and processed your registration form. You will then be contacted once we have determined your spot is confirmed.

Once your spot is confirmed you will receive your welcome packet which will include a welcome letter, activity calendar, and parent handbook.

Will field trips still be permitted?

For the safety of our campers, we will not be offering field trips as part of camp this summer.

Will you still be providing transportation?

Yes, camps will be operating with limited transportation routes.

Will the campers be allowed to swim?

Yes we are excited that all children will be able to swim under the guidance and directives from our local Board of Health, Department of Public Health, and the Governor.

What activities will be allowed at camp? For example Archery/Ropes Course.

We hope to have the children take part in as many traditional camp activities as possible based on the guidelines set forth by DPH.

Will you still be offering the camp lunch program provided by the Plymouth Public School System?

Yes, we'll still be offering lunch as part of our summer camp programming.
